We are pleased to announce that Aetna Better Health of Pennsylvania and NantHealth have partnered to give you access to **Eviti Connect**, an online software system that enables real-time decision support and treatment guidelines for **oncology** patients.

Effective August 3, 2020, there will be a **change of process** for **initiating** oncology treatment plan review requests. Below is a summary of these changes:

Purpose of Eviti	To provide specialist review of oncology treatment plans including
Connect	chemotherapy, radiation therapy and supportive medications
Uses of Eviti Connect	 Access to the latest evidence-based guidelines for radiation and chemotherapy Select from 3,800+ pre-built regimens, or customize treatments when necessary Discuss open treatment plan reviews with Eviti's clinical staff
Treatment Recommendations	Eviti Connect aggregates evidence-based recommendations from national government agencies, reports, and journal publications (including the NCCN Compendium, JCO, JNCI, Lancet, NEJM and JAMA)
Provider Training Sessions	Late July 2020: Several training sessions will be available to help you become familiar with using Eviti Connect to submit treatment plans for review. The training schedule will be sent in a future communication in June.
