Children 12 years of age and older are now able to get the COVID-19 vaccine.



If you are pregnant, you can get the COVID-19 vaccine. Getting vaccinated during pregnancy can protect you from severe illness from COVID-19.*



The virus that causes COVID-19 can replicate quickly and cause severe illness. Without the vaccine, your body may not be able to fight the virus in time.



If you are exposed to the virus after being vaccinated, the vaccine helps your immune system to recognize and fight the virus.*

Did you know?



Children can be infected with the virus that causes COVID-19. This means they can get sick and can spread COVID-19 to others. Children ages 12 and up can now get the vaccine.



The COVID-19 vaccine is **free** for everyone and Aetna Better Health® of Illinois members can receive up to **\$30 in rewards**.



There are 3 vaccines available to fight COVID-19:

- **Pfizer****—you need **2 doses** to be considered fully vaccinated
- **Moderna**—you need **2 doses** to be considered fully vaccinated
- **Johnson & Johnson**—you need **1 dose** to be considered fully vaccinated
