## Aetna Better Health® of Illinois 2022 Medicaid Pay-for-Performance (P4P) Program



The Aetna Better Health® of Illinois 2022 Pay-for-Performance (P4P) Program rewards providers for high-quality care given to our members.

### Here's how it works

Financial incentives are based on completing services on several Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) measures. Assigned PCPs and specialists are paid extra for closing these HEDIS® care gaps:



#### PCPs:

- Adult access to preventive care
- Blood pressure control (<140/90)
- Hemoglobin A1c < 8
- Breast cancer screening
- Well-child visit, 15-30 months: 2+ visits (6 or more visits within first 15 months)

#### Specialists or combo of PCPs/specialists:

- Prenatal care
- Postpartum care
- Cervical cancer screening
- Childhood immunizations by age 2 (combo 3)
- Follow-up services rendered by licensed behavioral health providers

#### Eligibility requirements

Every Medicaid recipient is required to have an assigned PCP. Starting in 2022, PCPs who see fewer than 35% of their assigned patients during the year (telehealth visits count toward this requirement) are not eligible for PCP incentives. In 2023, this will increase to 50%. We'll share visit performance data with providers throughout the year starting in Q2.

### Program update for 2022

Similar to 2021, providers receive financial incentives for completing services on several HEDIS® measures. For 2022, the incentive rate increases for reaching the target set for the 50th percentile, with another increase at the 75th percentile.

## Targets

Provider performance is based on three tiers (<50th, 50th–75th, 75th+) according to the following HEDIS® measures for claims through 12/31/2022:
