

Health and wellness involve many factors, such as where a person is born, grows, lives and works. Social determinants of health (SDoH) describe social problems, conditions or risk factors that may influence a patient's health.

SDoH data helps create a whole-person approach to health care — giving us a clearer picture of our members' needs so we can connect them to resources. It helps us coordinate efforts while supporting health equity and improving quality.

Aetna Better Health® of Illinois encourages providers to use the appropriate ICD-10-CM Z codes to document SDoH in the medical record. See page 2 for Z codes related to SDoH.

## You can help

**Educate your care team** about the importance of documenting SDoH data. Any clinician can document a patient's social needs — physicians, nurses, social workers, navigators, case managers and other care team members.

**Ask your patients** at each visit about SDoH factors affecting them.

**Use Z codes** to document SDOH in the health record. They can be part of the patient's history, problem or diagnosis list or in the provider's notes.

**Include SDoH codes** on claims you submit to our health plan.
