1. Location Code 99

Effective **June 1, 2016**, Aetna Better Health of Kentucky will not recognize location 99 when billing Home Health services. Please use the appropriate location code.

2. Vaccines Available

Vaccines noted below are now available for Aetna Better Health of Kentucky at Retail pharmacies for Specific age groups.

- For all members who are **19YO and over** the following vaccines may be ordered under the member prescription drug card benefit and administered at a participating pharmacy.
- Member <u>less than 19 YO</u>, will use of the vaccine for children's program from the PCP's office or the city county health department.
- Vaccines may also have limitations as listed in the vaccine package insert.
- Vaccine distribution and or availability may be altered as needed due to a regional vaccine shortage.
- Exemptions of Age limits for Pneumovax 23, Prevnar 13 may be altered below the age of 50 based on concominate chronic illness health status of a as determined by the prescriber. This would require a Prior-authorization to obtain the vaccine from a retail pharmacy.

The vaccines offered at the retail pharmacy are:

Flu - influenza vaccines (only the intramuscular injections) -

- ✓ There is not coverage for nasal administered vaccine such as flu-mist, unless a compelling medial need is not met or allergy exists to the injectable vaccine. Flu-mist would require a prior-authorization to obtain payment coverage.
- ✓ High strength Flu vaccine (Flu-Zone) that is generally age appropriate for 64YO and older is generally provided for by Medicare at age 65. The age limit for high strength flu vaccine for Aetna Better Health of Kentucky is 19YO to 64YO. Please check the member's eligibility to determine primary-secondary coverage of the vaccine if the member is disabled or is within Medicare coverage age.
- ✓ Flu remains seasonal from November to March yearly
- ✓ 1 injection per season

Gardasil- For reduction of cervical cancer due to Herpes virus

- ✓ Age restricted to the manufactures package insert of 18-26YO and females
- \checkmark This vaccine is administered over a period of time with three (3) consecutive injections.

PNEUMOVAX 23 or Prevnar 13- is a vaccine indicated for active immunization for the prevention of pneumococcal disease (Pneumonia)

✓ Age and dosing per product package insert, United States Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP), and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommendations

Zostervax- indicated for prevention of herpes zoster (shingles)

- ✓ 50 years of age or older and persons
- ✓ Given 1 time
