ABHLA will be reevaluating our SDoH Provider Incentive.

Currently, providers who screen ABHLA members for SDoH needs and bill with HCPCS code G0136 (ADMINISTRATION OF A STANDARDIZED, EV) and an appropriate diagnosis (Z) code are eligible to receive an incentive.

Effective 02/28/26, this provider incentive as it currently exists will be paused. Claims billed with date of service after 02/28/26 will not receive an incentive payment.

ABHLA is in the process of reassessing its SDoH provider incentive in an effort to reintroduce a new, more streamlined process that reduces administrative burden and increases net positive outcomes for our members.

We understand that SDoH assessments are an important tool in closing care gaps and that provider incentives are a reliable way to facilitate care as medical costs rise.

Please be on the lookout for announcements in the coming months as we restructure our provider incentive opportunities in a way that we hope will facilitate a full closed-loop process to better assess the needs of our members and ensure that they receive necessary care at every level.
