Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) Program

Rates effective 4/1/2020

- Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA-D) required to possess a doctoral degree in psychology or behavior analysis and pass a national certification exam.
- Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) required to possess a master's degree in psychology or behavior analysis and pass a national certification exam.
- Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA) required to possess an undergraduate degree and certification in behavior analysis. A BCaBA may only practice under the supervision of a BCBA or BCBA-D. A BCaBA may supervise a RBT.
- Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) a high school graduate with 40 hours of registered behavior therapy training and successful completion of a competency exam. They must practices under the close, ongoing supervision of a BCBA-D, BCBA or BCaBA.
