

OhioRISE Provider Interviews

As part of the evaluation of the OhioRISE program, the Ohio Colleges of Medicine Government Resource Center (GRC) will be conducting interviews of select OhioRISE providers. The goal of the interviews is to gather the perspectives of treatment providers related to OhioRISE processes and outcomes. Interview questions include topics such as:

- Coordination of care.
- Service provision.
- Child and family care teams.
- Program impact on children and families.

Results from the interviews will assist the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) in monitoring the effectiveness and transparency of their operations. Additionally, it will provide valuable insights for ongoing improvements that will enable ODM to better serve youth enrolled in OhioRISE and their families, as well the providers working with them.

GRC will reach out to select OhioRISE providers for 30-minute interviews, which will take place either online or over the phone. Interviews will be conducted starting in December 2023 through February 2024.
