



CODING POLICY CHANGES

July 26, 2024

We regularly revise our coding policy positions as part of our ongoing policy review processes. This notice is developed to keep you informed of the details of the upcoming new policies or policy changes for Aetna Better Health Kids (CHIP) based on Pennsylvania Medicaid Bulletins and up to date CPT and HCSPCS coding requirements.

Please note: Due to CHIP eligibility, these policies only apply to members up to age 19.

These new policies below are effective October 1, 2024.

Certified Nurse Midwife Services:

Code	Policy
84703	Will deny with place of service 11, 27 and female gender is not present.

Code	Policy
99202, 99203, 99204, 99205, 99212, 99213, 99214, 99215	Will deny when members age is greater than 18 years, and less than 10 years, with place of service 02, and modifier HD is present and female gender is not present.

Code	Policy
99202, 99203, 99204, 99205, 99212, 99213,	Will deny when members age is greater than 18 years and less than 10 years, with place of service 10 and modifier HD present and female gender is not present.

Code	Policy
99202, 99203, 99204, 99205, 99212, 99213, 99214, 99215	Will deny when members age is greater than 18 years, and less than 10 years, with place of service 11, 99, and modifier HD is present and female gender is not present.

This new process may result in a change in how your practice is reimbursed for these services.
