You are only allowed to get one monthly internet discount and one device discount per household.



Do I qualify?

- You may qualify if your household income is at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines.
- You may qualify if any member of your household participates in a government assistance program, such as:
 - No-Cost Children’s Health Insurance Program (CHIP)
 - Lifeline landline phone benefit
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - Medicaid
 - Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)
 - Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch or Breakfast Program including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision
 - Participation in a Federal Public Housing Assistance program
 - Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Federal Pell Grant (current award year)

What is considered a household?

A household is a group of people who live together **and** share money (expenses and income) even if they are not related to each other. If you **either** don’t live together **or** you don’t share money, you are two or more households.
