### The Power of the PCP

#### The PCP has a vital role in the ability to impact Dental Care

Addressing dental care, dental visits and benefits during well-child visits can be the catalyst for members going to have a dentist visit.



The PCP office might be the only opportunity to receive dental referrals, education and assistance establishing a dental home

# Annual Dental Visit (ADV) - Criteria

Who is in the measure (denominator)?

- Members age 2-20 as 12/31 of the measurement year
- Continuous enrollment
  - The measurement year

<u>Admin</u> Methodology

No chart review



# Annual Dental Visit (ADV) - Criteria

# What makes the member compliant (numerator)?

- Any visit with a dental practitioner during the measurement year meets criteria
  - ANY visit billed by a dental practitioner during the measurement year may apply.
  - May be preventative or treatment



## Children Receiving Preventative Dental Services (PDENT-CH)



# Children Receiving Preventative Dental Services/ PDENT- Criteria

#### Who is in the measure (denominator)?

- Children ages 1-20
- Enrolled in Medicaid or CHIP Medicaid Expansion for at least 90 continuous days
- Eligible for EPSDT services

# What makes the member compliant (numerator)?

- Received at least one preventative dental service during the reporting period
- Services MUST be provided by a dentist or under the supervision of a dentist



## Dental Sealants for Children Ages 6-9 at elevated caries risk (SEAL-CH)



# **Dental Sealants - Criteria**

#### Who is in the measure (denominator)?

- Children ages 6-9 as of 12/31 of MY
- Elevated risk of dental caries ('moderate' or 'high' risk)

# What makes the member compliant (numerator)?

 Received a sealant on a permanent first molar tooth within the measurement year

### Dental Care Challenges

### Why Gaps in Care?



### Parent/caregiver lack of understanding/awareness of:

- Dental benefits for 2x/year dental check-ups
- Recommendations to take to dentist no later than age 2, preferably by age 1 or when first tooth erupts
- Importance of early dental care to prevent significant problems
- 'Dental well-visit' just as important as medical well-visit
- Importance/benefit of sealant



- Fear / anxiety child or parent
- Geographical / county location
- Child cooperation
- 1-3 year olds and 18-20 year olds
- ACA Line of Business
- If tooth # of sealant not captured on claim
- Sealants performed at SBHC or mobile units and claims potentially not received
- Potentially volume of dental providers performing sealants



- Lack of dental referral / recommendation by PCP, particularly by age 2
- Dental providers that do not see Medicaid members
- Dental providers that do not see patients before age 2-3
  - ADV includes members who turn 2 in MY
  - PDENT includes members who turn 1 in MY



# Take Action!

### Take-Away Actions- Dental (ADV, PDENT, Sealant)

**Assess for dental** home and last dental visit

at every well-visit (or when in office if no well-visit yet in MY)

Refer for dentist visit no later than age 2

Ideally by 1 yr old, or can be as early as 1st tooth eruption

**Educate** parents/caregiver /older adolescents

**Benefits for** 2x/year dental check-ups

**Assist member to** establish dental home if needed

**Remind** parents/ caregivers

Of \$25 gift card for 2-3-year olds

**Educate that** dental well-visit

Is just as important as medical well-visit



### Take-Away Actions- Dental (ADV, PDENT, Sealant)

**Educate parents /** caregivers that dental decay

Can lead to significant health issues

**Educate** parents/caregivers that establishing dental care early

Is the best way to diminish fear

**Encourage** parents/caregivers of 6-9 year-olds

To discuss dental sealants with their dentist

Provide oral health/ dental anticipatory guidance

**Reinforce that** dentist visit is also necessary in addition to PCP education



# COMING January 2021

### **Adult Dental Benefit**

#### **Tentatively effective January 1, 2021**

- Annual \$1,000 adult dental benefits will be made available
- · Adult members 21 and over
- More information to come!

### Don't forget about existing adult <u>Value Add</u> benefits...

- Pregnancy dental benefit
  - Up to two free preventative dental visits
- Diabetes dental benefit
  - Type II diabetes in select counties
  - 21 and older
  - Routine dental care
  - Includes two exams, two cleanings and bitewing x-rays each year
