These claim Denials will have a denial remit message **"109 - CLAIM/SERVICE NOT COVERED BY THIS** PAYER/CONTRACTOR. YOU MUST SEND THE CLAIM/SERVICE TO THE CORRECT PAYER/CONTRACTOR." This will act as notification that the provider should resubmit for those claim lines to Original Medicare MAC.
