## **BOARD CERTIFICATION (with Expiration Date)**

This medical specialty certification indicates that this physician has received recognition for his/her expertise in a particular specialty or subspecialty of medical practice, achieved through a voluntary and rigorous process of testing and peer evaluation. Board certifications, when first offered, did not have an expiration date; however, recognizing the changing pace of medical knowledge recertification is now required to maintain the recognition. This information is validated by the health plan at the time of the credentialing. Our staff reviews this information at least every three years for all of our participating providers during recredentialing and through monthly reviews to update current changes.
