HEDIS® Measurement Year 2020 & 2021 Measures

Measure Description: This measure summarizes the number and percentage of members with an alcohol and other drug (AOD) claim who received the following chemical dependency services during the measurement year:

- Inpatient
- Intensive outpatient or partial hospitalization
- Outpatient or medication treatment
- ED
- Telehealth
- Any service

Eligible Population

Members 0 years and older as of December 31 of the measurement year.

The Following Members Will Not Be Counted in the Measure Population

Members in hospice.

Strategies for Encouraging Engagement in Dependency Services

- Refer members to services that offer a safe, supportive, and culturally competent environment.
- The patient needs quick access to treatment, this should be taken into consideration while choosing a chemical dependency service.
- Involve the patient’s family in making the decision of what chemical dependency service would be most beneficial for the patient.
- Staying in treatment long enough is critical for the patient’s recovery process.
- Medication regimen adherence is essential for the patient’s treatment.
